The **Caregiver Program** at Elder Services is designed to support caregivers through information, advocacy, and education. The primary goal of the program is to connect caregivers to existing community services that meet their needs, and support the needs of their care recipients.

In-home and telephone interviews are held to evaluate the caregiving needs, and then the family is provided with recommendations for addressing the needs that have been identified.

One of the program's main services to the community is the awarding of caregiving grants provided under the Older Americans Act, Title III programs. These grants are designed to serve educational, respite, support and training needs that help caregivers in their role to support their families and loved ones.
